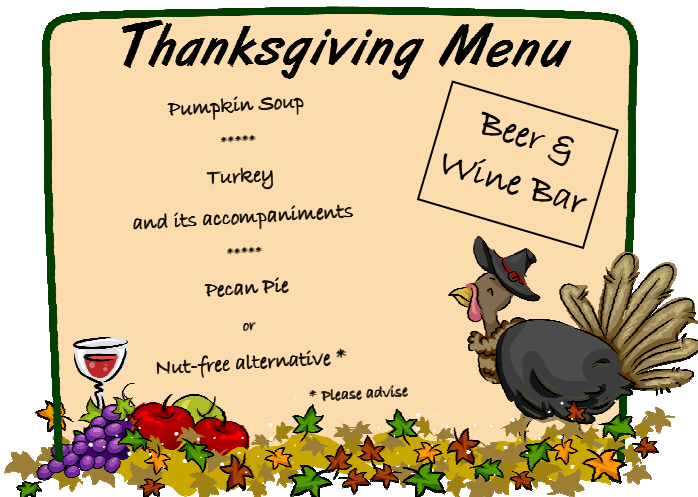

The CHICKS **Santa Sprint** is a festive family fun run in aid of CHICKS taking place in Callington on December 7th starting at 3.30pm.

The **Santa Sprint** will follow a route of approx 1.5 miles through Callington finishing in the town for the Victorian Christmas market, Christmas lights switch-on and the arrival of Santa on his sleigh.
